Bremer Community Center, Inc.'s Key Card Policies

You must have a key card - one time enrollment fee of \$25 per card, replacement cards are \$5.

Cost to use the facility is \$10 per month. You may only share your card among your immediate family members who live at the same address. You must list all people who will be using the card.

Key cards allow access to the building from 5 am to 10 pm.

Card allows users to walk in the facility (in the gym and multi-rec room), use the gym for recreation (shooting hoops, playing volleyball, etc.), and use of the multi-recreational room. Walking and use of the gym and multi-recreational room is on a non-exclusive basis.

There are additional fees to participate in leagues/classes (including but not limited to basketball, pickleball, volleyball leagues, martial arts and fitness classes).

If the gym/multi-rec room is exclusively rented (ie-scheduled on the calendar), walkers cannot walk in the gym/multi-rec room and other users may not use the gym/multi-rec room to shoot hoops, play volleyball, etc.

All children 18 and under must be accompanied by an adult - no exceptions.

If you have guests who use the facility with you, each guest must pay the single usage fee of \$3 for 18 years and under, \$5 for adults per time for walking or using the gym or multi-recreational room.

All payments for daily single usage may be placed in the black drop box located in the entryway. Please put your payment in an envelope and write your name on the outside of the envelope - envelopes are provided.

If desired, a walk through of the recreational spaces will be provided prior to signing up. The time must be arranged by you and the Bremer Community Center director.

The Bremer Center is a non-smoking/non-vaping facility.

All Bremer Community Center property – including not limited to televisions, technology devices, tables, chairs, sports balls, sports mats, sports nets, sporting equipment, etc. – must be used properly and maintained in good working order. Patrons who lose, steal, or misuse Bremer Community Center property may be personally liable for replacing or repairing the item.

Holder acknowledges that security cameras are used at our facility to ensure the security of the premises from theft, unauthorized access, or damage to the property. Monitoring devices are installed in the common areas, exterior, and parking areas. Holder agrees not to tamper with the devices.

The Bremer Community Center, Inc. reserves the right to revoke your key card and usage privileges. Reasons your key card could be revoked include (but not are not limited to) - allowing unauthorized users to access the facility with your card, inviting others to the facility and your guests not paying the usage fee, causing damage to the facility, or disrupting the use of the facility by others. Please take pride and ownership in your community center!

The expectation of the holder is that you will clean up after your gym/multi-rec room use. This includes:

- No liquids (exception of water) or food.
- Sweep floors if noticeable dirt, etc. (use push broom in the closet in the kitchen, then sweep dirt into dust pan)
- Place equipment back in its designated place.
- Turn the gym lights, multi-recreational lights and equipment storage room lights off.
- Check bathrooms and shut off lights.
- Shut off all lights in the hallway/lobby.
- Make sure the doors are locked and the building is secured.
