



## **Bremer Community Center, Inc.**

### **Membership Policies**

We have two facilities - the Bremer Community Center ("Bremer Center") building and the Penner Athletic Courts ("PAC"). You may have a membership to just the Bremer Center, just the PAC, or a combined membership that allows you to use both the Bremer Center and the PAC facilities. Membership fees are adjusted annually. Membership fees through December 2024 are as follows:

Bremer Center only: \$10 per month

PAC only: \$25 per month

Combined membership: \$30 per month

Access to both facilities is through a key fob. You must have a key fob. There is a one time enrollment fee of \$25, which includes one key fob. Replacement fobs are \$10. You may only share your fob among your immediate family members who live at the same address. You must list all people who will be using the fob.

Key fobs allow access to the building from 5 am to 10 pm.

Fobs allows users to walk in the facility and use the gym for recreation (shooting hoops and playing volleyball). Walking and use of the gym is on a non-exclusive basis.

There are additional fees to participate in leagues and conduct practices (including but not limited to basketball, pickleball, volleyball leagues, martial arts and fitness classes).

If the facility is rented (which will generally be shown on the calendar), walkers cannot walk in the rented areas and, if the gym is rented, members may not use the gym to shoot hoops, play volleyball, etc.

All children 17 and under must be accompanied by an adult - no exceptions.

If you have guests who use the facility with you, each guest must pay the single usage fee of \$5 per time for walking or using the gym..

All payments for daily single usage may be placed in the black drop box located by the front doors. Please put your payment in an envelope and write your name on the outside of the envelope - envelopes are provided.

If desired, a walk through of the recreational spaces will be provided prior to signing up. The time must be arranged by you and the Bremer Community Center director.

There is no smoking or vaping in either the Bremer Center or the PAC.

All Bremer Community Center property – including not limited to televisions, technology devices, tables, chairs, sports balls, sports mats, sports nets, sporting equipment, etc. – must be used properly and maintained in good working order. Patrons who lose, steal, or misuse Bremer Community Center property may be personally liable for replacing or repairing the item.

Members acknowledge that security cameras are used at our facility to ensure the security of the premises from theft, unauthorized access, or damage to the property. Monitoring devices are installed in the common areas, exterior, and parking areas. Members agree not to tamper with the devices.

The Bremer Community Center, Inc. reserves the right to revoke your key fob and membership privileges. Reasons your key fob could be revoked include (but not are not limited to) - allowing unauthorized users to access the facility, inviting others to the facility and your guests not paying the usage fee, causing damage to the facility, or disrupting the use of the facility by others. Please take pride and ownership in your community center's facility!

**The expectation of the member is that you will clean up after yourself. This includes:**

- NO LIQUIDS (exception of water) OR FOOD on the gym floor.
- Sweep floors if noticeable dirt, etc. (use a push broom in the equipment storage room and dust pan.)
- Place equipment back in its designated place.
- Turn off the gym lights.
- Check bathrooms.
- Make sure the doors are locked and the building is secured.

**All activities must be supervised by an adult at all times. Appropriate footwear is to be worn in the gym. No food or drink (other than water) is allowed in the recreational spaces. Only approved balls and equipment are allowed.**
